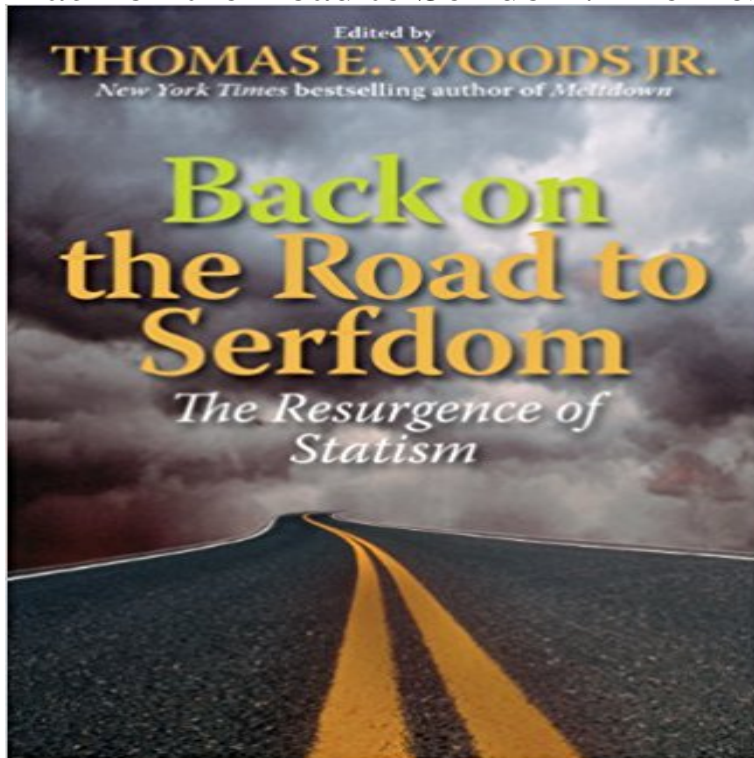


Back on the Road to Serfdom: The Resurgence of Statism
