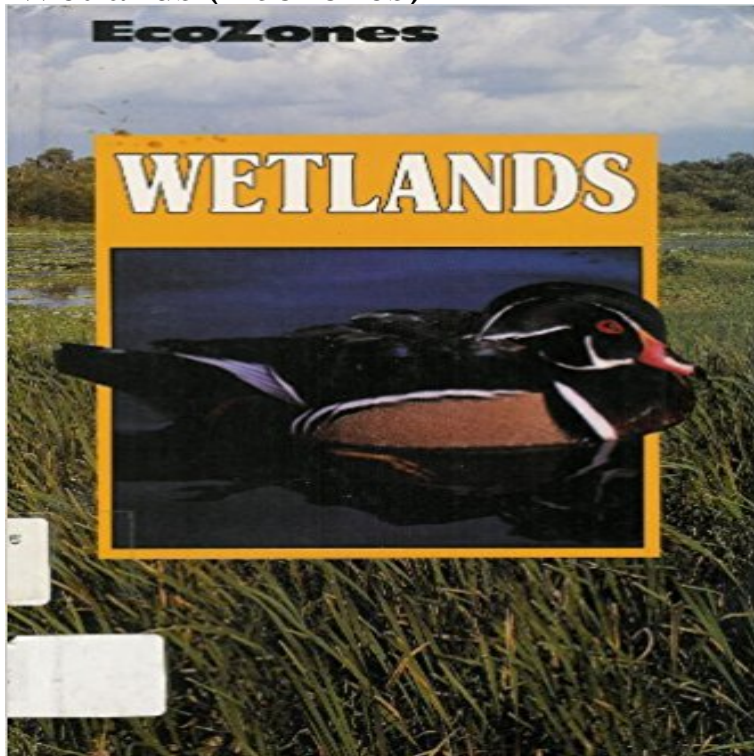


Wetlands (Ecozones)
