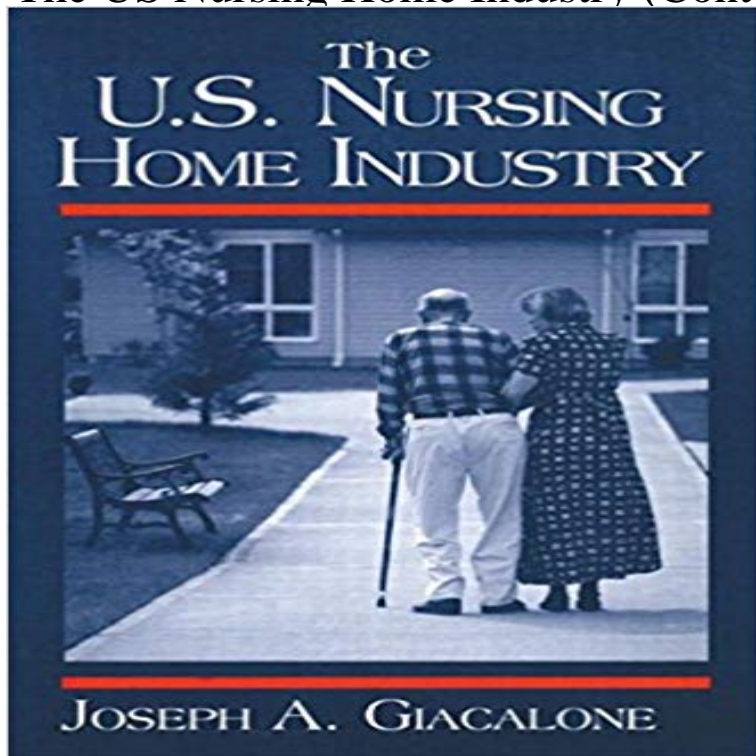


The US Nursing Home Industry (Contemporary Industry Studies)
