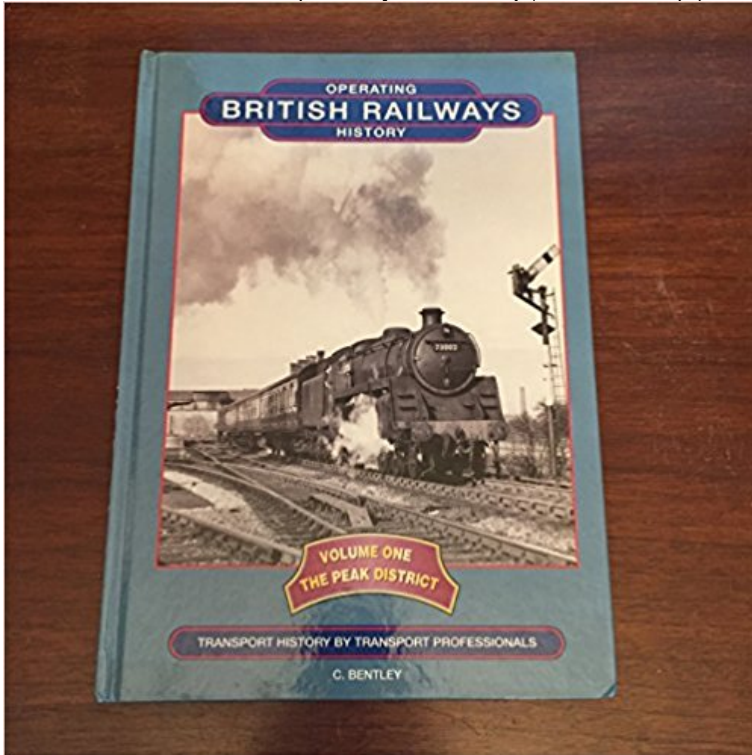


British Railways Operating History, Vol.1: The Peak District
