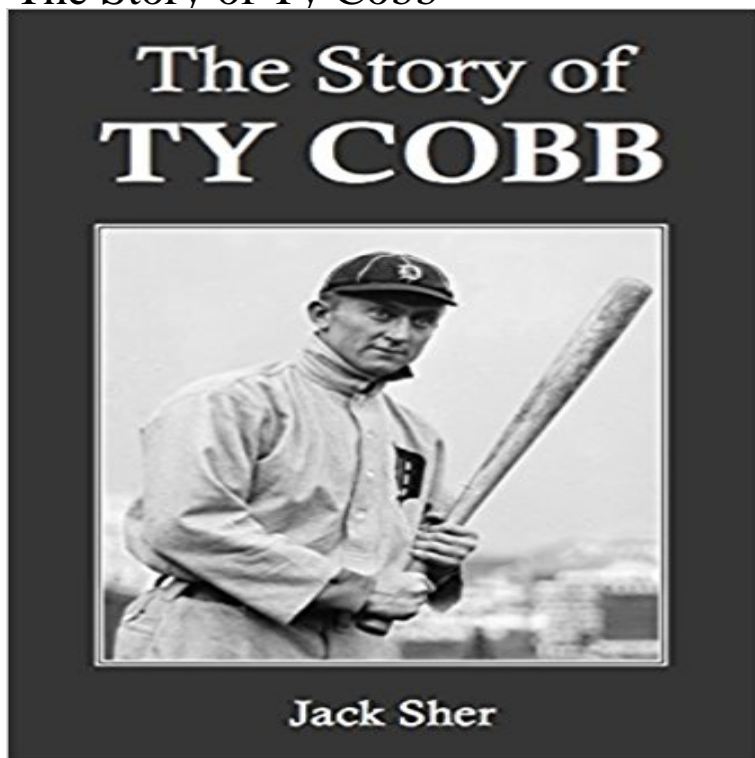


The Story of Ty Cobb
