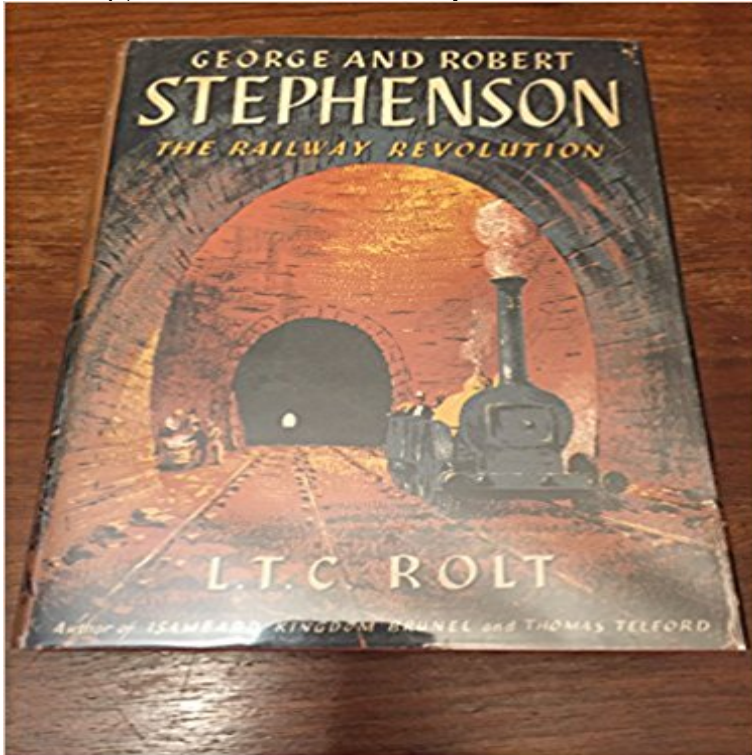


George and Robert Stephenson: The Railway Revolution
