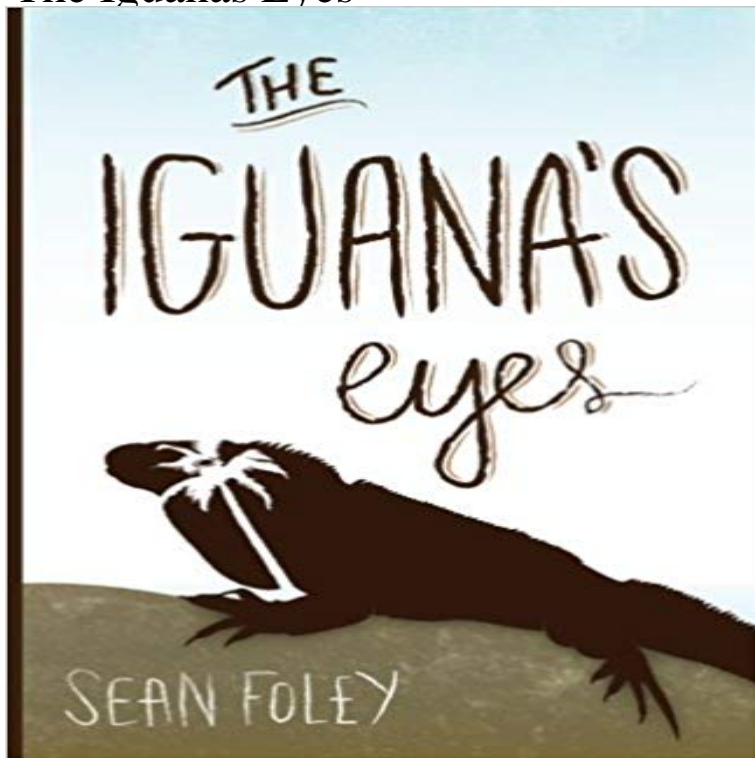


## The Iguanas Eyes
