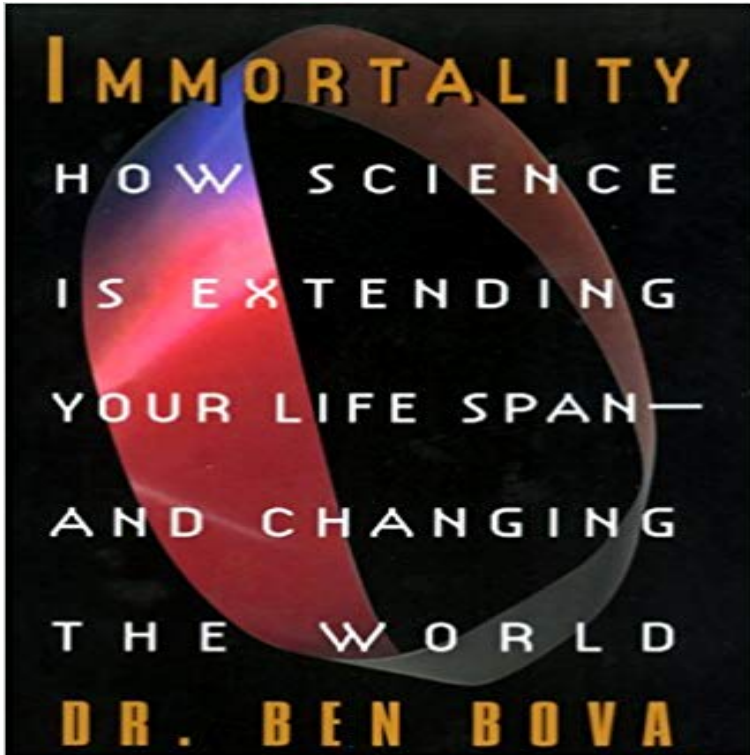


Immortality:: How Science Is Extending Your Life Span--and Changing The World
