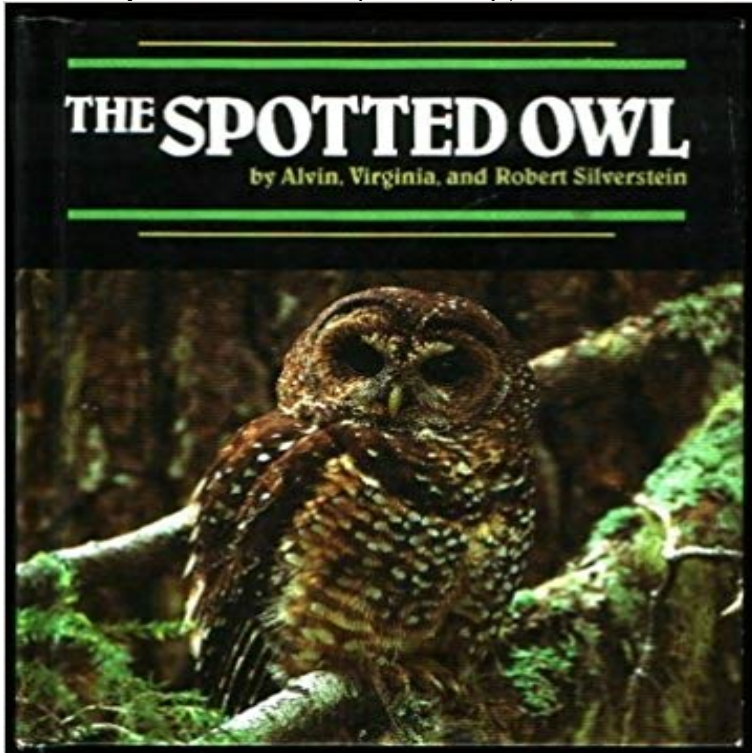


The Spotted Owl (Endangered in America)
