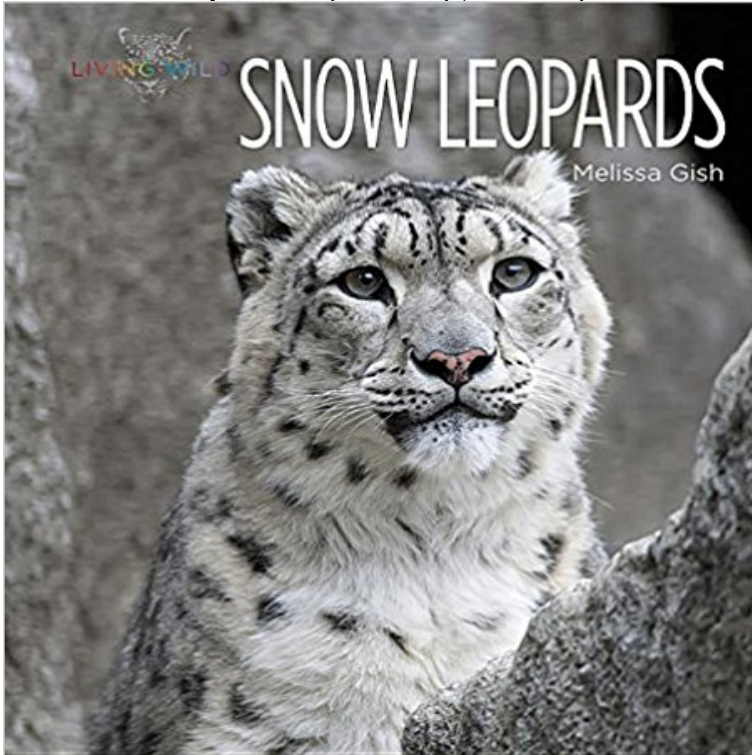


Snow Leopards (Living Wild)
