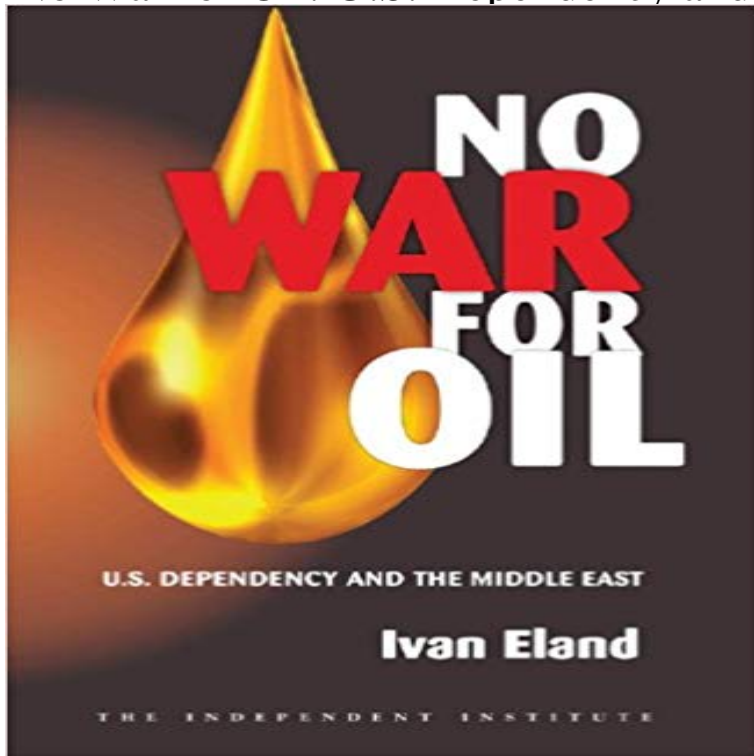


No War for Oil: U.S. Dependency and the Middle East
