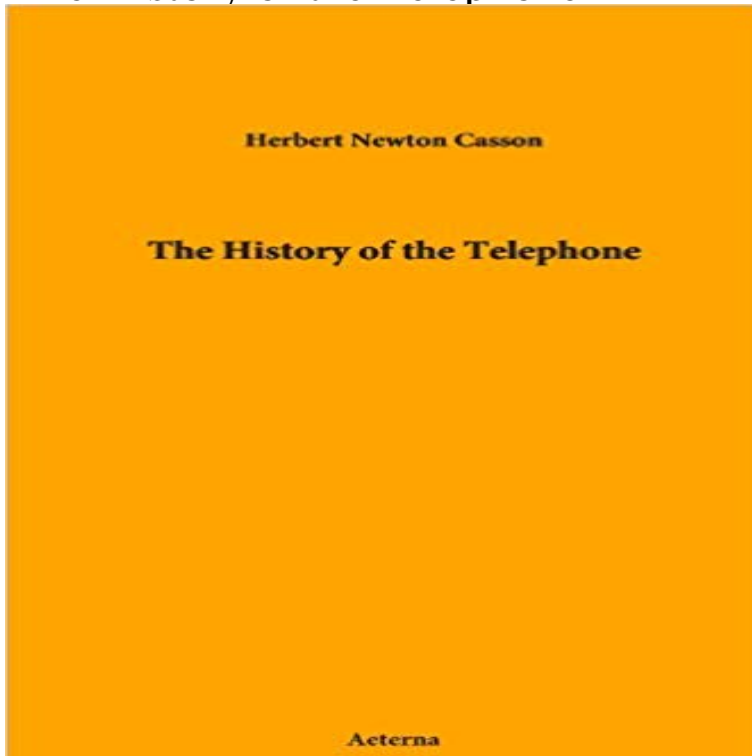


The History of the Telephone
