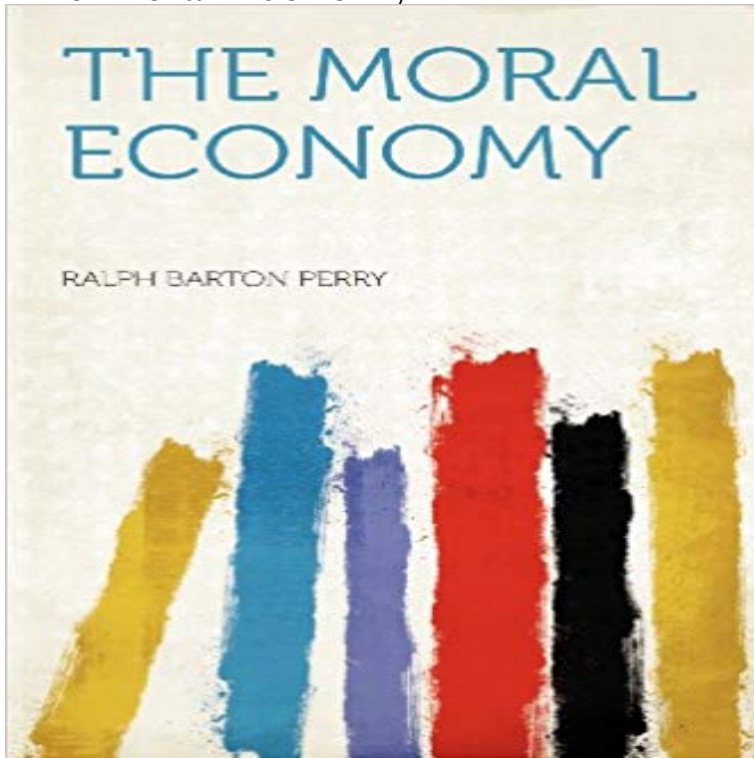


The Moral Economy
