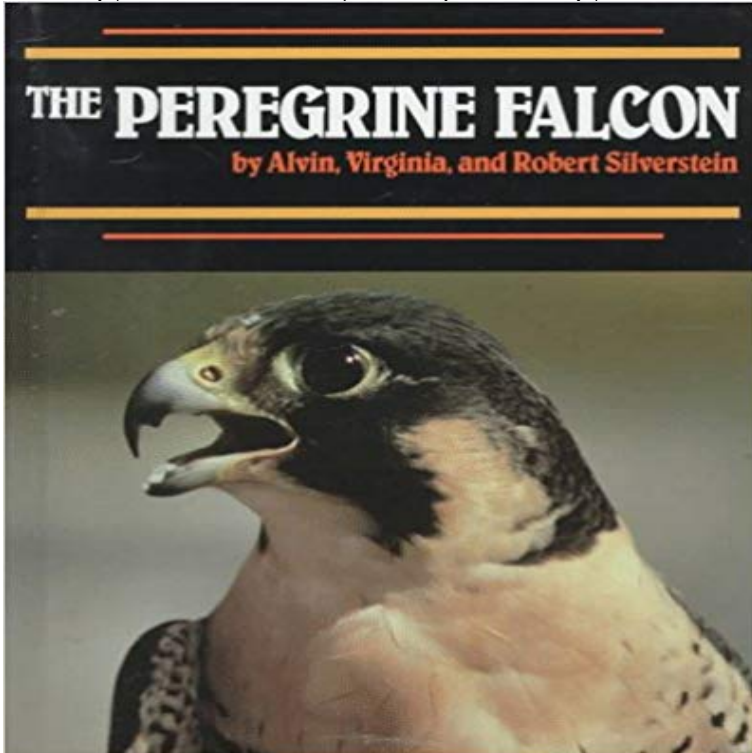


Peregrine Falcon, The (Endangered in America)
