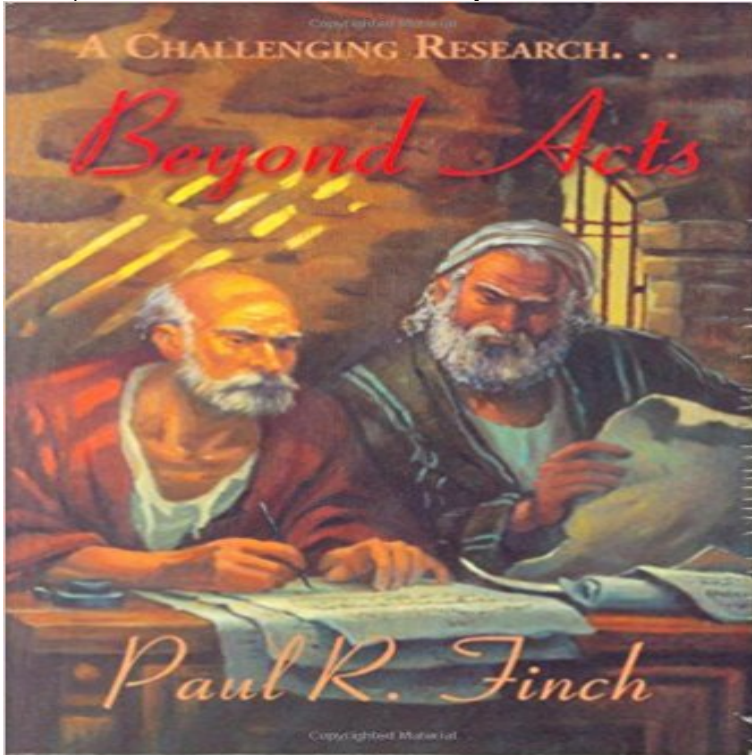


Beyond Acts: New Perspectives in New Testament History
