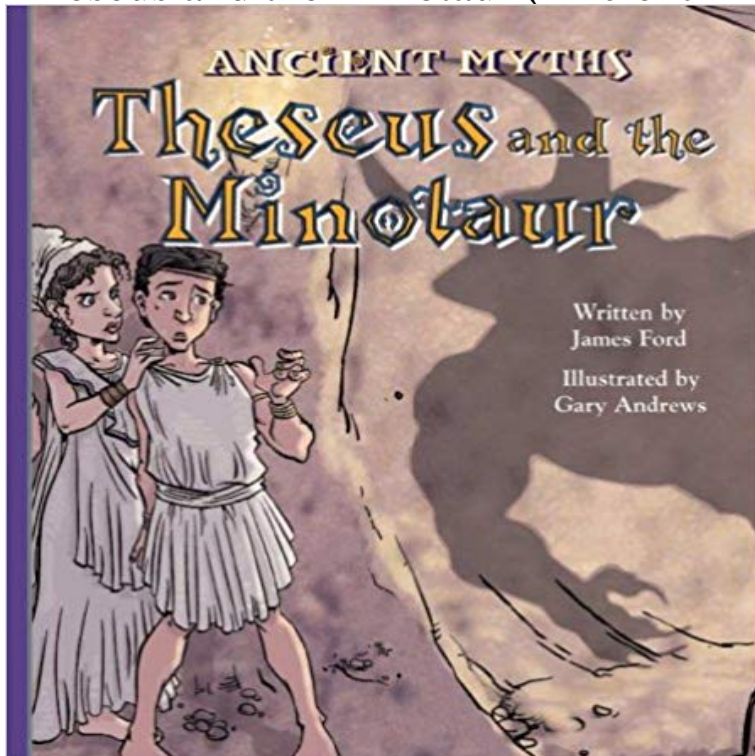


Theseus and the Minotaur (Ancient Myths)
