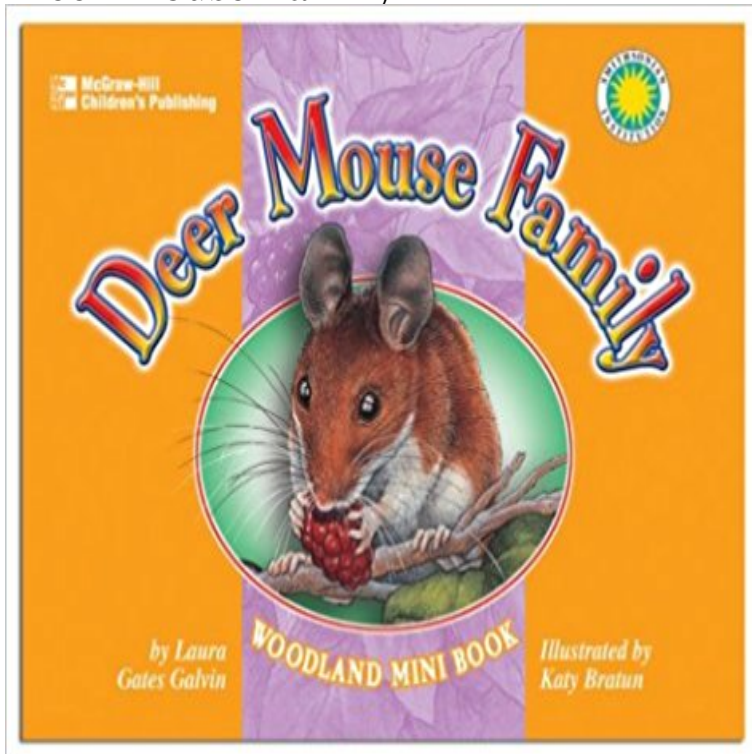


Deer Mouse Family
